## **Garland City Water**

The city is continuing the process of replacing water meters. These water meters have not been transmitting electronic readings into our accounting system, but the meters have still been recording the water usage to your home. If you notice an increase in your water bill over the next few months, please contact our city offices. We will be happy to review your account and address any concerns. Thank you for your understanding as we work to improve our water metering system.

#### **Snow Removal Reminder**

Parking Prohibited During Snow Removal: To ensure effective snow removal this winter and maintain safety, no vehicles may be parked on City streets during snow removal operations. This parking restriction is in effect when snow is actively being cleared and any time snow removal is deemed necessary. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us keep our roads clear and safe for everyone. (Code 5-8-3R)

Property owners are responsible for promptly clearing snow from the sidewalks in front of their properties. If snow is not removed, the city may clear it and charge the cost to the owner. Please remember that snow from the sidewalk and driveways cannot be shoveled, blown, or plowed in

the street or public right-of-way. Thank you for helping keep our sidewalks safe! (Code 6-1-11)


