

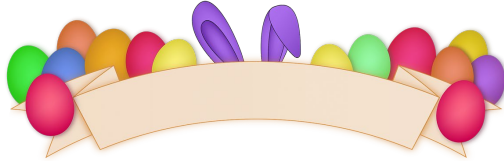

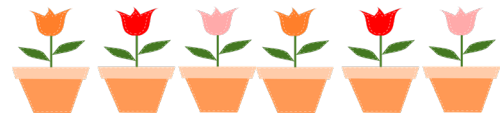

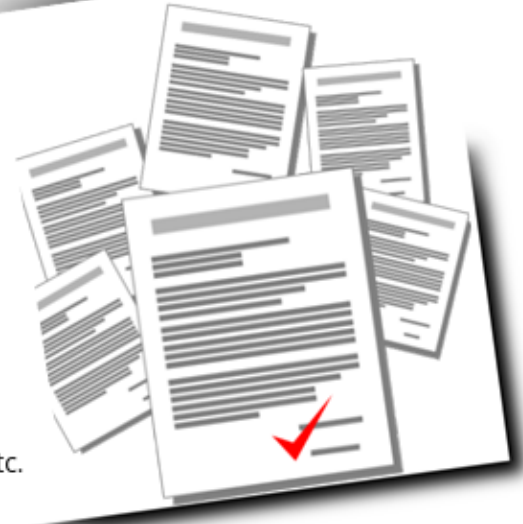
DOCUMENTATION

What you might need on your worst day.....

DOCUMENTS TO INCLUDE:

- ✓ **Birth and/or Death Certificates, Marriage License**
- ✓ **Social Security Card, Passports/Visas**
- ✓ **Driver's License and/or Identification Card**
 - See URS Other Acceptable Documents
- ✓ **Insurance Documents:**
 - Property, Vehicles, Life, Medical, Specialty, Business
- ✓ **Tax and Social Security Information:**
 - Yearly, Filing Status, Rollovers, Annuities, Benefits
- ✓ **Property, Business and Other Ownership**
 - Wills, Deeds, Trust, Investments, Powers of Attorney
- ✓ **Medical:**
 - Insurance Cards, Records, History, Disability Declarations, etc.
- ✓ **Prescriptions:**
 - Medications, Glasses, etc.
- ✓ **Employment Records, Military Service and VA Records**
- ✓ **Financial Information: RECOMMEND FINANCIAL ADVISOR! [*Roche Financial Group](#)**
 - *Bank, Credit Cards, Cash, Precious Metals Status, CDs, Safety Deposit Boxes, Other. One statement from each with account # and contact information.

***If you are the only one on your bank or other account(s), the money goes to the state and unclaimed assets account in the event your death. PUT SOMEONE ELSE ON YOUR ACCOUNTS!**
- ✓ **Household Information:**
 - Monthly bills, utilities, automated withdrawals, Apple/Google/Amazon Account information (Apple TV)
- ✓ **Funeral Arrangements**
- ✓ **Personal Account Information:**
 - Passwords (book, list, etc.): email, iPod/iPad, computers, ALL accounts
- ✓ **Pet Records:**
 - AKC/Pet Registration, Vaccinations, Veterinarian Contact, Animal Hospital, Photos, etc.
